Course Numbers

FA1981 – WI1997	Courses are represented by a two digit subject code followed by a four digit (and/or character) code.
SU1997– WI2015	Courses are represented by a three or four character subject code followed by a four digit (and/or character) code. The first digit of this code indicates the year level of the course. Upper year courses not assigned a specific year level are coded as level 9.
SU2015 – present	Courses are represented by a four character subject code followed by a four or five digit (and/or character) code. The first digit of this code indicates the year level of the course.

Course Credit Values

FA1981 – SU1995	Most courses are full-year courses. The standard course weight of 1.0 credit represents minimum 78 hours class time.
FA1995 – present	Most courses are semesterized. The standard course weight of 0.5 credit represents minimum 36 hours class time.
